Dear Lobethal Entrant,

A great big warm WELCOME to the Lobethal Grand Carnival and the chance to "Blast through the Past" on Australia's longest, and arguably greatest, road racing circuit.

After almost two years of intense planning, it is with great excitement that we urge you to submit an **ENTRY (attached)** and reflect on the heroism and raw courage of the fast men of a long forgotten era, who would be just a little bemused at our efforts to relive their true glory days. **ENTRY FORMS** may also be downloaded from the event website - www.lobethalgrandcarnival.com.au - Event Entry chapter.

As this unique event, proudly supported by Clipsal 500 Adelaide and in conjunction with the Sporting Car Club of SA Inc., draws closer and interest mounts, there are a few key items we'd like you to take on board:

ELIGIBILITY

Acceptance of entries remains strictly subject to the criteria outlined under **CATEGORIES** on the Expression of Interest forms on the Participation Page of the event website, or Item 7 on the Supplementary Regulations and final acceptance will be at the discretion of the promoters. It's critical that this event has the correct "look and feel" and when its imagery is presented to the world, it must look like a true tribute to the machines of yesteryear.

ACCOMMODATION

Please refer to the event website for assistance in selecting from a range of accommodation options we have suggested which are located primarily within a radius of Lobethal. If further help needed, please contact Pauline Renner - Carnival Co-ordinator (see below).

NUMBERS

As we expect a full muster, forget preferred numbers. If your machine carries a historically significant number, you can leave it in place, but you will need to apply the official Lobethal Grand Carnival allotted number, which will be issued when you register at the event paddock.

PACKETS

All cars and bikes will be assembled in groups, which we are calling "packets". Machines will be assembled in "packets", travel on track as a "packet" and each "packet" will have a lead and a tail and the number issued to each participating machine will clearly show your "packet" number.

CLOSED PUBLIC ROADS

As the Lobethal Grand Carnival is being held on major public roads which will be closed for the event, thereby disrupting many a motorist, please note that form up and on-track timing require a very exact schedule and failure to present at form up within the time frames notified may lead to exclusion from the session involved. And please be kind to all members of the SA Police Force and all Event Officials. They only get to watch!

DRIVING STANDARDS

We are very fortunate to be able to partake of Lobethal in this unique "spirited" demonstration. So please do the "R thing". Take note of the times by which you must report, either in person, or with your machine, let us know if you have any problems, and above all else, drive in a manner that will not put you, your passengers, other entrants, or most importantly, the event at risk! As you know this is not a race and as such, you don't need a full racing licence, your car/bike doesn't need a logbook, and neither you nor your machine should ever be unduly stressed. But you do need a Basic Licence (see below). This also applies to Reserve Drivers.

PASSENGERS

Very fortunately, where seats are available, passengers may share the thrills, watch the road and perhaps even limit your ability to embellish your feats! See the Supp Regs for details, but in essence, it's a great way to share the joy! Passengers must be signed in for insurance reasons, and an entry fee applies per session.

LICENCES

Check the Supp Regs to ensure you have the right licence in place. If you are not a member of an affiliated CAMS club, no problem. At sign on, when you register, either at Vintage Collingrove or at Lobethal, you will be offered honorary Sporting Car Club membership for a month. This covers you for insurance and will save you some cash when you purchase your basic licence to run. For bike riders, you do not need to be a Club member to obtain an MA licence to run at Lobethal.

BUMP-IN

Cars and bikes may be bumped in to the event paddock between 1pm and 5pm on Thursday October 9th or between the hours of 10am and 5pm on the Friday, October 10th. Detailed unloading instructions will follow, and a team of pushers will be on hand to help. Make sure you tell 'em about any aluminium panels!! Trailers and tender vehicles will be housed away from the paddock and shuttle transport will be available to ferry drivers and crew.

VINTAGE COLLINGROVE/MID-WEEK CLUB BREAKFAST + BIRDWOOD BBQ

Have a go and forget the cost of petrol for a whole week! Act today and plan a full-on historic racing week by coming to Vintage Collingrove (the preceding weekend, October 4-5), and from 8:30am on Wednesday, October 8th, enjoy BREAKFAST at the Sporting Car Club of SA Clubrooms (access the Club's awesome Library) at 51 King William Road, Unley. From 12:00noon, a BBQ/PICNIC will be staged at the famous National Motor Museum at Birdwood in the Adelaide Hills. A motoring feast and ALL are welcome. See Cost Summary sheet.

B-Y-O FUEL

Fuel will not be available at the event. You must bring your own in approved containers with appropriate filling device, either a member of your family, or better still, a jiggler. Refueling will be permitted in the paddock and only when your car/bike is parked in its allotted "packet" area.

CAR/BIKE COVERS

Bring a suitable lightweight waterproof car/bike cover as the weather is not guaranteed and parking is on the Lobethal Lutheran School Oval (in the open, but with security).

SOCIAL EVENTS

For all Entrants, there are three main happenings. Things kick-start with Cocktails (locally brewed beer and Lobethal wines) at the Lobethal Bierhaus on Friday, October 10th from 5.30pm. On Saturday night, what else! The Charleston Cabaret where the back-straight village of Charleston gets naming rights to a night of crazy cabaret in the period piece Lobethal Centennial Hall. This one carries a charge, but equally we expect you to get one!

And on Sunday after the final run, there will be a Closure with all entrants to assemble for Trophy Giving and Thanksgiving!

1. EVENT

The event shall be known as the "Lobethal Grand Carnival Demonstration". It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the CAMS 'Guidelines for Demonstrations, Parades and other Non-Racing Laps', these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and Bulletins that may be issued by the Organisers. This Event will be an Historic 2+4 Demonstration, and will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au
Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS manual.

Each participant will receive 4 sessions (2 each day). The event will also be run in conjunction with an MSA demonstration Permit.

6. DATE and VENUE

The 'Lobethal Grand Carnival Demonstration', here in after known as the meeting will be held on the old Lobethal Race Circuit, South Australia, on Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th October, 2008. The track is 14km in length consisting of public roads (Lobethal Mt Torrens Road, Onkaparinga Valley Road, Lobethal Woodside Road, Woodside Road, Main Street), closed for the meeting, and direction of the demonstration is clockwise.

Track density- Vehicles will travel in groups of 20 consisting of a lead and follow vehicle.

7. FUEL

Requirements as per Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Fuel will not be available at the circuit.

8. ELIGIBILITY

- **1.GENUINE** - racing and competition sports cars that actually ran, or were entered, for any original Lobethal event (1937/8, 1939, 1940 and 1948)
- **2.TYPE** - same make/model of cars as above but not original Lobethal entrants (eg: Alfa P3, MG K3)
- **3. PERIOD** - racing cars of the era (approx. 1920-1948) that did not run at Lobethal (eg: Auto Union, ERA)
- **4. HISTORIC** - cars outside the period - from 1900 to 1962
- **5. RESERVE HISTORIC** - racing and competition sports cars only 1963-1975. This extension is included only to cover featured marque and anniversary celebrations etc.

9. LICENCES

Minimum of CAMS Level 2SE licence, which must be presented at Documentation with your Current CAMS Affiliated Club Membership.

10. CHANGE OF DRIVERS

Any proposed substitution of nominated drivers (after the date of closure of entries) must be notified to the Event Secretary at least one hour before the scheduled time of the relevant session. The substitute driver must meet the above licence requirements.

Entry form must be completed in full and lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting. Faxed entries will not be processed until payment is received in full. The maximum number of entries will be 300.

Such fees shall not be refundable except

- (a) In the case of abandonment, cancellation or postponement of the meeting, in accordance with NCR 59.
- (b) In the case of the entrant's car being withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Meeting no less than 14 days before the Meeting.

A fee of \$25 will be charged to cover administration costs associated with a refund. Any cheque dishonoured will incur a fee of \$25 plus any bank fees.

Event Organisers may refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83.

12. SCRUTINY

Times for scrutiny are to be advised in the Further Regulations. **THIS IS ONLY A SAFETY CHECK.** Times and details of drivers briefings will be advised in Further Regulations.

13. ADVERTISING

Refer to current CAMS Manual Schedule K, 5th Category Historic Cars General Regulations and NCR 155.

14. SAFETY APPAREL and EQUIPMENT

Refer to Schedule D for Safety Apparel Drivers and Passengers, and Schedule H for Fire Extinguisher requirements of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

15. PARADE AND DEMONSTRATION LAPS

Invited cars will take part in Parade and Demonstration laps. This activity will be conducted under CAMS 'Guidelines for Demonstrations, Parades and other Non-Racing Laps'

16. ALCOHOL

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

17. GENERAL

In the event of an accident involving any damage to facilities or the use of a Fire Extinguisher, the competitor/s involved will be responsible for covering any costs of replacing the Fire Extinguisher and cost of damage. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.
